

Pastor's Sunday Sermon Recap...

A recap allows us to revisit key takeaways, meditate on biblical truths, and apply them to our daily lives.

By revisiting the sermon's themes, scripture, and challenges, we create space for transformation. We are reminded that God's Word is not just something we hear—it is something we live.

Sermon Title: "Straighten it Out, LORD!"

Sermon Text: Luke 13:10-16

Date Originally Preached by Pastor Fomby: Sunday, March 16, 2025

In this sermon, Pastor Fomby explored the theme of being seen and recognized by God. In the sermon, we witnessed the powerful moment when Jesus called forward a woman who had been afflicted for 18 years. This moment illustrates the profound intimacy of God with His people, demonstrating that He notices our struggles even when we feel invisible. It's a reminder that God sees us in our pain and desires to heal and restore us.

Being called by God is transformative. Just as the woman straightened up and praised God after her healing, we, too, are encouraged to respond in gratitude for the care and attention He gives us. How often do we allow our challenges to keep us bent over, unable to see the blessings around us? Today, reflect on how God is calling you to rise above your circumstances and embrace your identity as His beloved.

- What burdens or struggles do you need to bring before God today?
- How can you remind yourself of your identity as a beloved child of God?
- In what ways can you allow God to help you straighten up and move forward?
- Pray for the courage to lift your gaze and seek God's presence in your life.
- Ask God to reveal areas where He wants to bring healing and restoration.

Passion Week Message...

The Passion and the Cross of Jesus

Passion Week: April 13-20, 2025 "Live into the Story"

Passion Week is so named because of the <u>Passion</u> with which Jesus willingly went to the cross in order to pay for the sins of the world. Passion Week begins with the triumphal entry of Jesus on Palm Sunday on the back of a colt as prophesied in Zechariah 9:9.



The Passion of Jesus (also known as Holy Week) is depicted in all four Synoptic Gospels which occurs the week before Easter. It is the time from <u>Palm Sunday</u> leading up to <u>Easter Sunday</u> (Resurrection Sunday). Also included within <u>Passion Week</u> are <u>Maundy Thursday</u>, <u>Good Friday</u>, and <u>Holy Saturday</u> (the day that Christ lay in the tomb after his death).

Following the trials, Jesus was scourged at the hands of the Roman soldiers, then was forced to carry His own instrument of execution (*the Cross*) through the streets of Jerusalem along what is known as the <u>Via Dolorosa</u> (way of sorrows). Jesus was then crucified at Golgotha on the day before the Sabbath, was buried and remained in the tomb until Sunday, the day after the Sabbath, and then was gloriously resurrected.

Passion Week demonstrates the ultimate sacrifice for our sins. It is a time for prayer, reflection, examination, and submission for the greatest sacrifice for God's human creation. How does Jesus' sacrifice for you dwell in your heart to make the alternate human sacrifice to pick up your cross daily alongside Jesus and follow Him?

Let us pray. Our Father and our God, I call upon the Holy Spirit to be my strength and my guide during this Lenten Season to make it different from the other encounters. During this Lenten Season, through prayer and fasting, I will be able "To live into the Story" of the Passion and Cross of Jesus. I know Jesus' journey to the cross was a painful sacrifice, but He did it for me. I'm forever grateful, and whatever it takes for me to carry my cross, I know I will not be alone. In Jesus Name I pray. Amen!


