From The Desk of the Pastor...

Beloved Mt. Calvary Family,

Grace and peace to each of you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Commitment: **Worship.** We reminded ourselves that worship is not a weekly event but a daily posture—an offering of our whole selves back to the One who gave us life. Worship is where we breathe in God's presence and remember who we are in Him.

Last month, we focused on our first Kingdom

This month, we turn our attention to the second Kingdom Commitment: **GROW**.

Growth is at the very heart of discipleship. Jesus never called us to remain where we started. He called us to *follow Him*—and following means moving, maturing, becoming. The apostle Paul reminds us in Romans 8:29 that we are "predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son." In other words, the goal of the Christian life is not simply to know about Jesus but to become more like Him.

Growth does not happen by accident. Just as children mark their height on a wall, disciples of Christ should be able to look back and see evidence of their spiritual development. Growth requires intentionality. It means submitting every area of our lives—personal, family, church, and even civic life—to the Lordship of Christ. It means aligning our will with His, even when His way challenges our comfort or confronts our preferences.

At Mt. Calvary, we are committed to creating an environment where growth is possible. That's why we gather for Bible Study, why we nurture prayer, why we stress accountability in community, and why we encourage you to spend daily time in God's Word. Growth takes time, but it also takes effort. A five-year believer who applies themselves can be more mature than a twenty-year believer who refuses to move beyond the basics.

So my question to you this month is simple: **Are you growing?** Are you becoming more patient, more loving, more generous, more Christ-like in your walk and witness? If Jesus spent a week in your shoes, would He recognize His reflection in your decisions, your priorities, your relationships?

This October, I challenge each of us to take one step forward in growth. Read more Scripture. Pray with greater consistency. Join a Bible study or small group. Stretch yourself in service. Journal what God is teaching you. Growth is not about perfection—it is about progression.

Family, let us commit together to grow, not just in knowledge, but in character, wisdom, and faith. For a tree that is planted deep and nourished well will surely bear fruit that lasts.

October National Awareness



Breast Cancer Awareness Month, held in October every year. This awareness aims to promote screening and prevention of the disease, which affects one in eight women in the United States every year and 2.3 million women worldwide.

Known best for its pink theme color, the month features a number of campaigns and programs — conducted by groups ranging from breast cancer advocacy organizations to local community organizations to major retailers — aimed at: supporting people diagnosed with breast cancer, including metastatic breast cancer educating people about breast cancer risk factors stressing the importance of regular screening, starting at age 40 or an age that's appropriate for your personal breast cancer risk fundraising for breast cancer research



October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month, also known as Intimate Partner Violence Month. Approximately one in three women, and one in four men will experience some form of intimate partner dating violence or domestic violence in their life time.

First observed in October 1981 as a national "Day of Unity," <u>Domestic Violence Awareness Month (DVAM)</u> is held each October as a way to unite advocates across the nation in their efforts to end domestic violence.

Communities and advocacy organizations across the country connect with the public and one another throughout the month to raise awareness about the signs of abuse and ways to stop it, and to uplift survivor stories and provide additional resources to leaders and policymakers.
